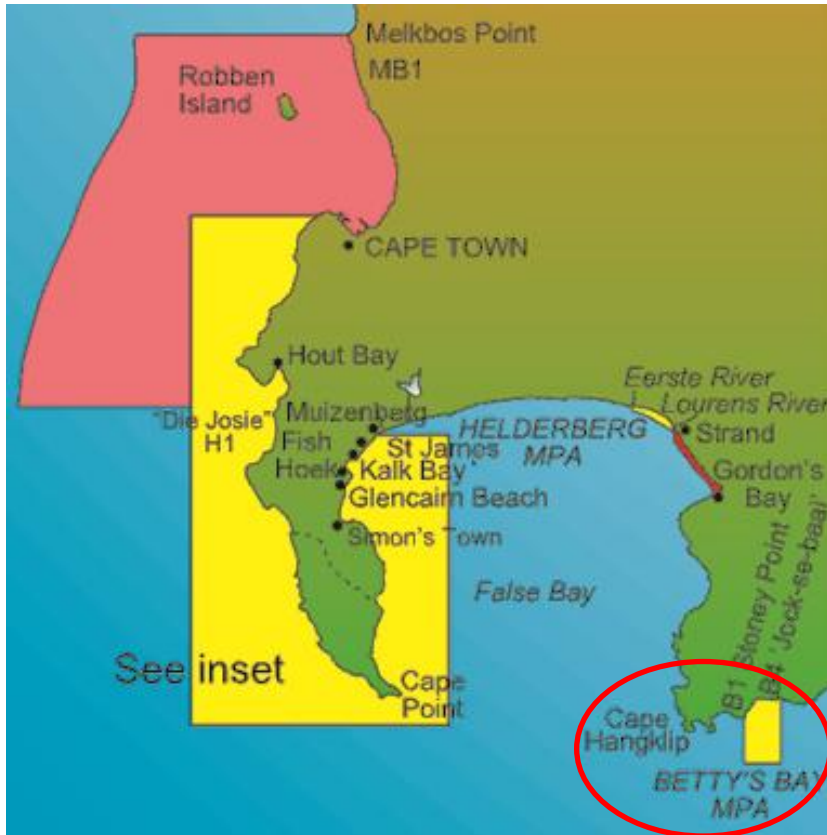


Rezoning of Betty's Bay MPA – Notice of Stakeholder Engagement Process

In line with the National Protected Area Expansion Strategy (NPAES, 2008), the Department of Environmental Affairs (DEA) intends re-zoning Betty's Bay Marine Protected Area (MPA). This will affect where recreational fishing and diving are allowed in this MPA. A public participation process is being run in accordance with requirements contained in the Marine Living Resources Act (Act 18 of 1998) and the National Environmental Management: Protected Areas Act (Act 57 of 2003) to enable Interested and Affected Parties (I&APs) to provide input into this process. I&APs are encouraged to register as stakeholders in this process and to attend a public meeting to be held on 27 March 2014 at 18h00-20h00 at the Crassula Community Hall, Crassula Avenue in Betty's Bay.
