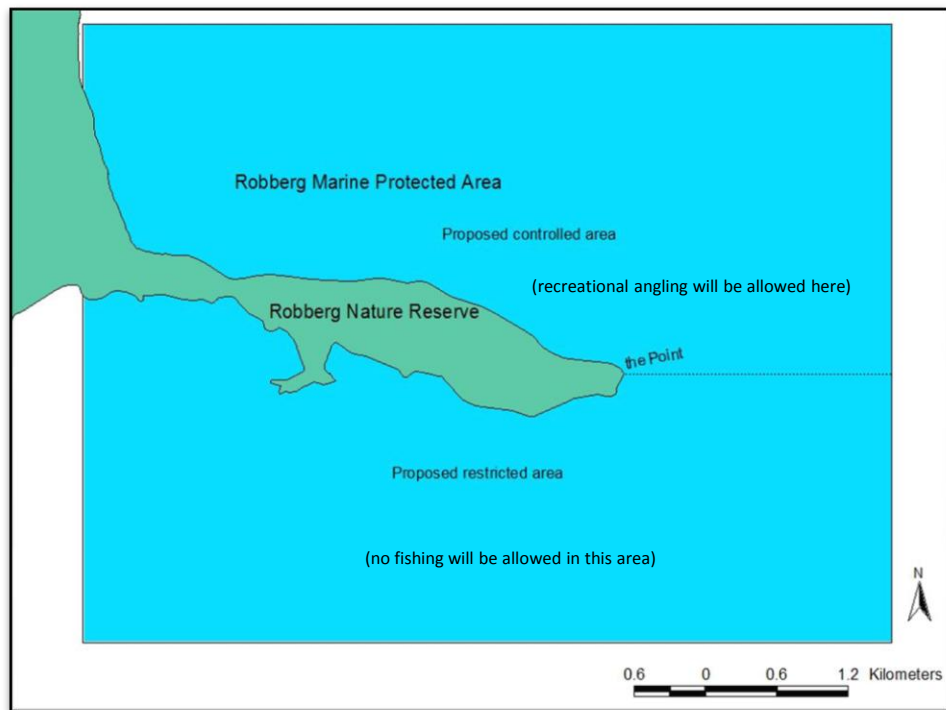


Rezoning of Robberg MPA – Notice of Stakeholder Engagement Process

In line with the National Protected Area Expansion Strategy (NPAES, 2008), the Department of Environmental Affairs (DEA) intends re-zoning the Robberg Marine Protected Area, such that recreational angling from the shoreline on the southern aspect of the peninsula will no longer be permitted. A stakeholder participation process is being run in accordance with requirements contained in the Marine Living Resources Act (Act 18 of 1998) and the National Environmental Management: Protected Areas Act (Act 57 of 2003) to enable Interested and Affected Parties (I&APs) to provide input into this process. I&APs are encouraged to register as stakeholders in this process and to attend a public meeting to be held on 21 March 2014 at 10h00-12h00 at the N.G. Kerk, Marine Way in Plettenberg Bay.
